

2019 CPT Code for Anticoagulation Monitoring

Medicare will pay for services related to home and outpatient international normalized ratio (INR) monitoring services.

- 93793 = Anticoagulation management for INR monitoring
- Anticoagulation management for patients taking warfarin, must include review and interpretation of a new home, office, or lab international normalized ratio (INR) test result, patient instruction, dosage adjustment (as needed), and scheduling of additional test(s), when performed

Cost considerations when testing INR in office

Supplies: Testing device, strips, lancets

Staff: Front desk managing check-in/check-out, nurse to conduct testing, compliance management, appointment reminders, phone calls

Average national office reimbursement:

85610 (finger stick) = \$ 4.85

99211 (nursing visit) = \$15.66

\$20.51 total

Office reimbursement for patients on service with mdINR:

National payment amount = \$12.85 per test
